





Legal Aid Clinic, School of Law, IIMT in collaboration with District Legal Services Authority Shahdara, East and North-East conducted an Awareness Programme on the topic 'Provisions and Issues related to Cyber Crime' on 11th May 2022 at 10:00 a.m. onwards for the students of BA LLB course in the Main Auditorium of the Institute. The Programme was organized under the able guidance of Prof. (Dr.) Arun Gupta, Principal, School of Law, IIMT; on the occasion of 'National Technology Day' for celebrating Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav.

The event was graced by the august presence of the Sh. Pranat Kumar Joshi, Secretary DLSA Shahdara District, Sh. Vinik Jain, Secretary, North-East DLSA, and Ms. Saema Jamil, Secretary, East DLSA as distinguished guests

The Programme witnessed a lecture and a dialogue by the revered judges as the keynote speakers for the day. The Programme was organized with the aim to provide the students with an insightful experience and understanding of the key aspects of related laws along with the societal constraints of the present-day world.

The Programme commenced with the lighting of the lamp and felicitation of the Hon'ble speakers and dignitaries. The first session was delivered by Dr. Parikshet Sirohi, Assistant Professor, University of Delhi. He discussed the legal aspect and provisions related to Cyber Crimes. Dr. Sirohi initiated the talk by putting emphasis on the significance of data via-a-vis one's privacy. He also put forth his views on the possibility that the next World War can take place because of violations of Cyber Data. His talk geared toward various facets of Cyber Stalking, Extortion, Spoofing, Cyber Crimes, and Cyber Forensics. He also discussed various crime investigation case studies, and the session also witnessed discourse on Privacy Policies for various applications that are freely available to society at large. Dr. Sirohi advised the usage of disposable E-mail Accounts, and explained the implications of the same. He also discussed the NETIQUETTES - the network etiquette, the dos and don'ts of online communication. He apprised the gathering about various Certificate Courses offered by Universities in India. His talk concluded with the usage of security countermeasures from AdBlock Plus, Dumpster, ChatSecure.org, VirusTotal.com, downtrace, and others. Dr. Sirohi concluded by cautioning the audience of the consequences and urged everyone to take precautions to safeguard against cybercrimes.

Thereafter, the second session was delivered by Inspector Sanjay Kumar, S.H.O. Cyber Police Station, Shahdara, Delhi. He explained that every citizen is living in two worlds simultaneously. One is the "REAL" world, and the other is the "VIRTUAL" world. While existing in the real world, we take all security precautions possible to remain safe and secure. In spite of knowing the laws, most of us operate otherwise. He discussed in-depth knowledge concerning different types of cybercrimes such as Access to Data without Permission, Data Theft, Damaging Computers, Denial of Access, Access to Unauthorized Persons, Identity Theft, Cyberstalking, and Cyber Terrorism. The preventive measures to be taken to safeguard oneself were also discussed at length. Thereafter, the gathering was sensitized towards the legal aspects which were eloquently taken by the Hon'ble Judge and Speakers for the day. The Awareness Programme then proceeded towards the Question-Answer Round. The round aided in furthering clarity over the concerned topic.

The concluding remarks were given by Sh. Pranat Kumar Joshi, Secretary DLSA Shahdara District. He advised to be cautious of the cousin domains (which are the deceptively similar to the domains of trusted websites and companies). He extensively addressed various possible solutions that an individual can go through for avoid online Scams. Mr. Joshi brought into light the implications and repercussions the offense of sextortion, i.e. a practice of extorting sexual favors from someone by threatening to reveal evidence of their sexual activity. He also brought to notice the improper use of Artificial Intelligence. He emphasized the need to

sanitize each person's phone by revoking unnecessary permissions, uninstalling unwanted applications, and deleting sensitive information to ensure that a step is being taken to protect against the ocean of new-age cybercrimes.

Thereafter, a letter of appreciation was presented to the revered speakers and distinguished guests for their gracious presence. A formal Vote of Thanks was delivered by Ms. Prema Gulati, Sr. Assistant Professor, School of Law, IIMT.

The event was attended by 138 students of BA LLB course along with all the Faculty Members of the School of Law.







The Training Programme was organized under the guidance ad tireless efforts of the Revered Prof. (Dr.) Arun Gupta, Principal, School of Law, IIMT for pproaching the DLSA and for the prompt execution of this program.

The Training sessions comprised of various lectures and dialogues with the Revered Judges of DSLSA and various DLSA's and each of the sessions were dedicated to legal topics of prominent value for the Para-Legal volunteers which will in turn be beneficial to them during their work as PLVs under the diverse aid programs of DSLSA.







Legal Aid Clinic, School of Law, IIMT with DLSA (Shahdara) jointly organized a Nukkad Natak. It was conducted on the occasion of International Women Day i.e, on 8thMarch, 2022 at Patparganj Village and Shresth Vihar. The object behind these kind of program was to initiate an awareness campaign with respect to the provision of free legal aid in common people.

The Programme was organized under the guidance and tireless efforts of the Revered Prof. (Dr.) Arun Gupta, Principal, School of Law, IIMT with DLSA and for the prompt execution of this program. The objective of the Nukkad Natak is to promote an inclusive legal system to ensure fair and meaningful justice to the marginalized and disadvantaged sector.

As a part of this program and after practicing for a week the volunteers from ideal Institute of Management and Technology and School of Law performed a street play at two different locations namely, Patparganj Village and Shresth Vihar.
