

2.7.1 Student Satisfaction Survey for Academic year 2022-23

The period covered for Student Satisfaction Survey was 1st August, 2022 to 31st July, 2023.

279 students filled the feedback form available on the institute website as a part of the Student Satisfaction Survey. The institute is using the same questionnaire as designed by NAAC for collection of student responses for SSS. Majority of the students were satisfied by the teaching learning processes and the quality of teaching in the institute. They find the teachers supportive, encouraging, motivating and helpful. Some dissatisfaction among some of the students was on account of space like no proper playground, bigger canteen etc.

The suggestions given by the students are summarized below:

- 1. Promote Student & Cultural Exchange
- 2. Call pass out students as guest lecturer so that they can give experiential insights
- 3. More practical sessions for developing soft skills
- 4. More career counseling sessions
- 5. More of practical knowledge of the procedures of court
- 6. More field visits
- 7. Participation of more students in Moot Courts
- 8. Engage students in practical training to make them industry ready.
- 9. More internships and placement facilities
