Topic: Preamble: Soul of the Indian Constitution

Date: 13th October, 2022

Brief Report:

In accordance with the traditions of the institute the session was commenced by offering tribute to the goddess Saraswati followed by felicitation ceremony. The brief outline of the topic was laid down and the resource person of the session was welcomed

and introduced.

Objective: To disseminate the nitty-gritty of the soul of the constitution and to aid the students to use the preamble not only to appreciate the Constitution of India but also to interpret other statues.

Brief Summary: The speaker elucidated about the origin, historical developments and evolution of the preamble. He quotes Dr. B.R. Ambedkar "... What we have stated in this Preamble are not legal and political principles only. They are also great moral and spiritual principles and if I may say so, they are mystic principles. In fact these were not first legal and constitutional principles, but they were really spiritual and moral principles. ... Take democracy." and his speeches to aid appreciate the aspects of the Constitution with the help of the Preamble. He further discussed various historical developments and the evolution of the preamble, he also spoke about the relevance of the Preamble to the Constituent Assembly. He aptly discussed various relevant case studies in his lecture.



The event commenced by welcoming the hon'ble chair along with the revered and learned guests to the auditorium. The luminaries, thereafter, paid tribute by lighting the lamps and

showering flowers on the idol of Goddess Sawaswati to evoke blessings of the 'Goddess of Knowledge, Fit and The tone of the Session was laid down by the In-Charge of the Clinic, Mr. Jasdeep Singh in form of the concept note delivered at the very outset of the session. Thereafter, the dignitaries

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The Director of the Institute Prof. (Dr.) Anil Parkash Sharma in his welcome address commended the efforts of the convening team in organizing the session themed around the current situations of Harassment of Women and Cyber Crime, and providing an active platform for sensitizing those present and involved around the issues and challenges faced in

The revered speaker for the day Prof. (Dr.) Ritu Gupta, National Law University Delhi was bringing about the coherence of the same. graciously called upon for the distinguished talk. Madam commenced the session with the way the guidelines given by the hon'ble Supreme Court in the Vishakha's Case has helped in enactment of The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. The Act was enacted with the objective to provide protection against sexual harassment of women at workplace and for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and for matter connected therewith or incidental thereto. It defines sexual harassment as unwelcome acts or behavior (whether directly or by implication) namely, physical contact and advances, a demand or request for sexual favors, making sexually colored remarks, showing pornography, any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature. Any act of unwelcome and sexual nature shall be considered as sexual harassment. The speaker also informed the students that an aggrieved woman can file a written complaint to ICC from three months from the date of the incident and in case of series of such incidents within three months from the last such incident. However, any delay in filing the complaint can be condoned by the committee up to further three months. In case of physical or mental incapability of the aggrieved woman, her legal heirs or such other person as described in The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Rules, 2013 may make a complaint. On receiving the complaint the committee, before initiating an inquiry, may take steps to settle the matter between her and the respondent through conciliation and when a settlement is arrived no further inquiry is conducted. If the conciliation fails or any term of the settlement arrived at has not been complied with by the respondent, the committee shall proceed further with the inquiry. In case of filing of false or malicious complaint or false evidence the committee may recommend to the employer or District Officer to take action in accordance with the provisions of service rules or where no such service rules exist, in such manner as prescribed in the Rules. The talk provoked the audience to deliberate upon the current social situation and the way the same is being implemented in the nation.

Thereafter, the session shifted to its next and final leg wherein the revered keynote speaker Dr. Pavan Duggal, Advocate, Supreme Court of India addressed the audience via video conferencing. He laid forth the laws relating to Cyber Crimes in India, and also while deliberating put a lot of emphasis on the legal remedies available for the deprived. The remedial forums were explained in detail to the gathering. The hon'ble speaker also lay light upon the increasing use of the cyber space and urged the audience to put the resources to use in a safe manner. The gathering was witnessed deliberating upon the positives and the negatives of the social and other platforms available.

The sessions were followed by a moderation round wherein the students asked their queries, and the organizers witnessed the same being answered by the speakers in an elaborative and illustrative manner.

Thereafter, Prof. (Dr.) Arun Gupta, Principal of the School of Law addressed the gathering. Wishful and forward thinking was showcased in the talk. The above-mentioned address was followed by a special address by the scholarly Secretary of DLSA Shahadara, Sh. Pranat Kumar Joshi. Each one was recommended to fulfill one's duty with responsibility. Sir emphasized upon the role of youth today as the true wealth of our nation. He also showcased appreciation towards the members of the clinic for organizing an event encircling such crucial concerns.

The programme observed its conclusion in the shape of a National Song of India. The attendees stood and paid their respect and gratitude towards our motherland.



Keeping up with changing trends in virtual learning, School of Law, IIMT has been initiating pioneering techniques to provide holistic exposure and training to its law students. In pursuance of the same Ideal Law Society of IIMT organised an event to celebrate the World Human Rights Day on the theme "Dignity, Freedom and Justice for All". Prof (Dr.) Hemlata Sharma, Vice-Principal, School of Law and other faculty members of IIMT were present to grace the event.

The event was conducted in Room no 004 in which 38 students and all faculties including the dignitaries were present. The brief event was convened by Dr. Sangeetha Abraham (Sr. Asst. Prof.) and Mr. Ayush Atray (Asst. Prof.).

Session in brief

The event was commenced by the welcoming the Organisers, Faculties and students by the Anchor. The brief outline of the topic was laid down and the concept note was explained about the event.

Objective:

The aim of the event was to extend knowledge of students about human rights.

Brief Summary:

In the beginning Mr. Shashvat Jain, the anchor for the event, briefed the students about the relevance of human rights. He also apprised the students that this day is also celebrated as World Human Rights Day. The anchor was able to grab the attention of the participants

throughout the session by giving real life examples of human rights.



FIRST EDITION: LET'S TALK THE UNTALKED 16TH & 19TH DECEMBER, 2022

REPORT

Two days event of Intra-Debate competition was organized to enhance the speaking skills of students and to develop the reasoning and analytical skills of the students which are quite essential for the students who want to excel further in law.

Ideal Institute of Management & Technology and School of Law organized the program from 16th December, 2022 and 19th December, 2022. The goal of this competition was to further introduce the students to the contemporary and relevant legal issues. It is quite essential that a learning community needs to be developed where sharing and cultivating ideas enhance communication skills and move forward thereby empowering ourselves to see a better world. It adds to a greater advantage of knowing the various aspects in and around the world with different views for and against. It enlarges our scope of thought and knowledge.

The event was conducted in the Mini and Main Auditorium in which 17 teams participated comprising of 3 members each which comes to a total of 51 participants.

Session in Brief

Topic: "Youth and Taboo"

Date: 16th & 19th December, 2022

Objective:

Ideal Law Society, School of Law conducted and trained its students for Congressional Townhall Debate at Ideal Institute of Management and Technology in a two day event. The aim was to provide an intellectually stimulating environment to children to engage in a fruitful discussion and learn through experience the intricacies of debating, diplomacy and certitude.

Brief Summary:

The endeavor through this debate was to establish a paradigm change in the spirit with which International Congressional Townhall debates are conducted, as well as to provide the best of logistical support to the participants and adjudicators in order to facilitate a smooth and efficient parley. 17 teams were selected for the knock-out rounds by drawing lots. The Preliminary Round and Quarter Finale were judged by final year law students of the institute.

Panel of Expert Judges was constituted for the Semi- Finale and Finale comprising of Principal, School of Law, Vice-Principal, School of Law and Senior Assistant Professors respectively.

Two teams with three speakers each faced off against each other in each debate to argue a set motion. Every round was held in a knock-out format with one winning team emerging at the end of a series of challenging debates. The motions were formulated from a suggested reading list which was made available to the students before the competition.

It followed a debating format which is sui generis in nature, a potpourri of world's leading debating formats like British Parliamentary system, Karl Popper Style of Debate and U.S. Presidential Debates.

Finale which was held on 19.12.2022 witnessed a Panel of 7 Juries along with two Voting Polls, one was held before the debate and other was held after the debate, tried to influence the decision of the Panel of Expert Judges but couldn't as the Panel of Expert Judges gave a unanimous judgment in the Finale Round.
