

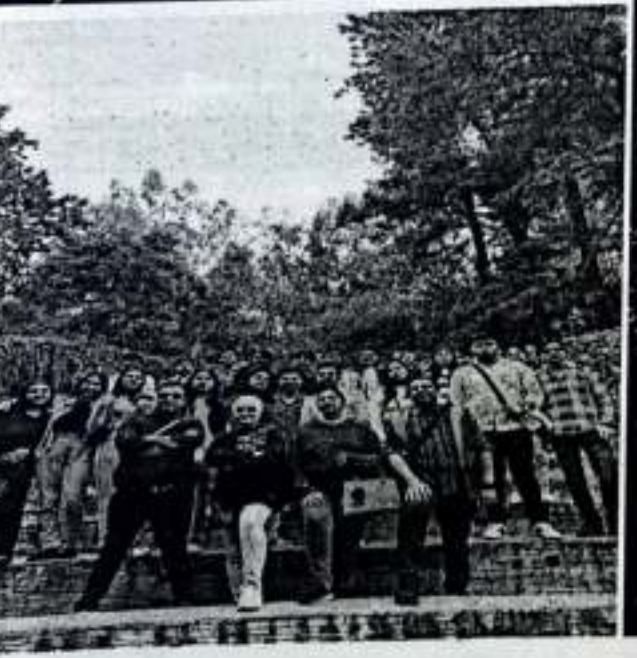



Theme of the Activity:	To understand the role of court and its various functionings in dispensing justice.		
Activity Date(s):	21/02/2024	No. of Participants:	21
Brief Description of the Guests/Participants (like industry experts, students, faculty etc):			
<p>A court visit was organized by the Legal Aid Clinic, IIMT in association with District Legal Service Authority, Shahdara on 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2024 for 21 students of 1<sup>st</sup> year students of B.A LL.B. studying at Ideal Institute of Management and Technology and School of Law. The students were accompanied by Dr. Jasdeep Singh, Associate Professor and Mr. Sidharth Rathore, Assistant Professor, from the institute. DLSA, Shahdara organized this court visit for the students of IIMT for providing them with practical insights of the legal proceedings as well as for giving them a firsthand experience of the working of the courts and the duties of the judicial officers.</p>			
Brief Description of Activity:			
<p>The students reached the court at 10:00 a.m and were seated in the conference hall of DLSA Room No. 35A. There was a meeting with the concerned DLSA officers and an introduction about the Karkardooma courts administration was given to them. The court visit started after the formation of students into groups and each group assisted by the officers of DLSA Shahdara. First court room visited by the students was the Family Court Room No. 4. The students got to experience and observe the court proceedings of matrimonial disputes such as divorce cases between the parties and the issues of custody of child. The students experienced the process of cross examination of a victim which was being conducted in camera recording. During the process the judge's remarks and the overall atmosphere of the court staff was also noted by them. In his court the statement of a witness was recorded. Students also did interaction with some advocates where they shared their experiences of being the part of the profession. Further there was a session conducted by judge in-charge of mediation centre Ms. Manjusha Wadhwa. She briefed them about the role of mediation in deciding the cases and its advantages. It was an interactive session where many doubts of the students were addressed. For the winding up of the visit the students reassembled back in the conference hall of DLSA. The Secretary of DLSA Shahdara, Sh. Anshul Singhal, held an informative session about the need of DLSA and the various functions performed by them like: (1) providing free legal aid, advice and services to eligible persons; (2) promoting spirit of amicable resolution of disputes by organizing Lok Adalats and through other forms such as mediation and conciliation and counseling (3) Spreading legal literacy and awareness amongst the masses. The visit came to an end at 1:40 pm. This court visit left the students enriched and motivated for a greater learning experience in the legal field.</p>

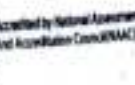

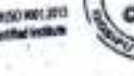

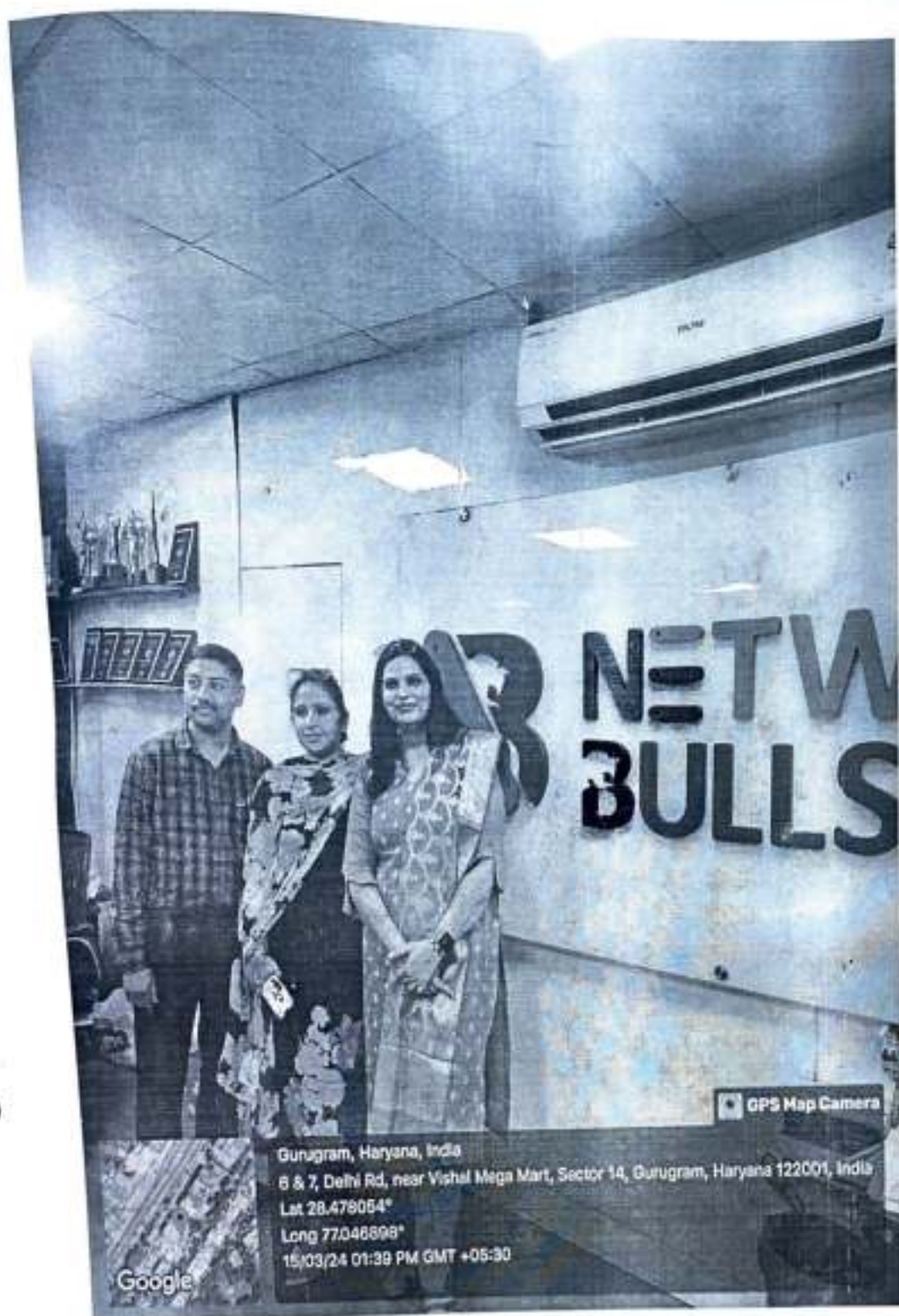

A Jail Visit was organized for the School of Law students by the Legal Aid Clinic, IIMT in association with DSLSA. The students were accompanied by two faculty members of the School of Law, IIMT, namely, Dr. Jasdeep Singh (Associate Professor), Ms. Anjali Nair (Assistant Professor).			
Brief Description of Activity:			
The Jail Visit was designed to enhance the students understanding of the intricacies of the legal system through firsthand observation and making them professional ready.			
<u>Different activities in Mandoli Jail:</u>			
1. <b>Meditation Hall:</b> For cleansing and disciplining mind, Yoga and meditation classes were started in a big way with the help of various voluntary organizations. We saw that the Staff members were also encouraged, to attend meditation courses.			
2. <b>Educational Facilities and Vocational Training:</b> Both adult and formal education arrangements have been made for prisoners. Educational activities are looked after with the help of Government resources.			
<u>Infrastructure Experience:</u>			
1. <b>Tailoring:</b> This unit is primarily started for imparting vocational training to convicts for post release rehabilitation. This section caters to tailoring requirements of prisoners and it also sells in different jail canteens. We saw some prisoners sewing some under-garments and handkerchiefs.			
2. <b>Bakery:</b> Baking factory basically caters to bread requirements for morning tea. With the introduction of modern technology, this unit has now started manufacturing varieties of biscuits, cakes, namkeens etc. These products are not only available for sale through Dry canteens of various Jails but are also supplied to various Government departments.			
3. <b>Kitchen:</b> There is huge hall for kitchen in which there are big electronic flour grinders and machine for making chapattis and also have gazettes for mixing up the flour. The inmates prepare their food for themselves. We also tasted the food that was made by inmates themselves. The food was hygienic and tasty. Also, prisoners are served food according to their strict diet chart, catering to their balanced diet needs.

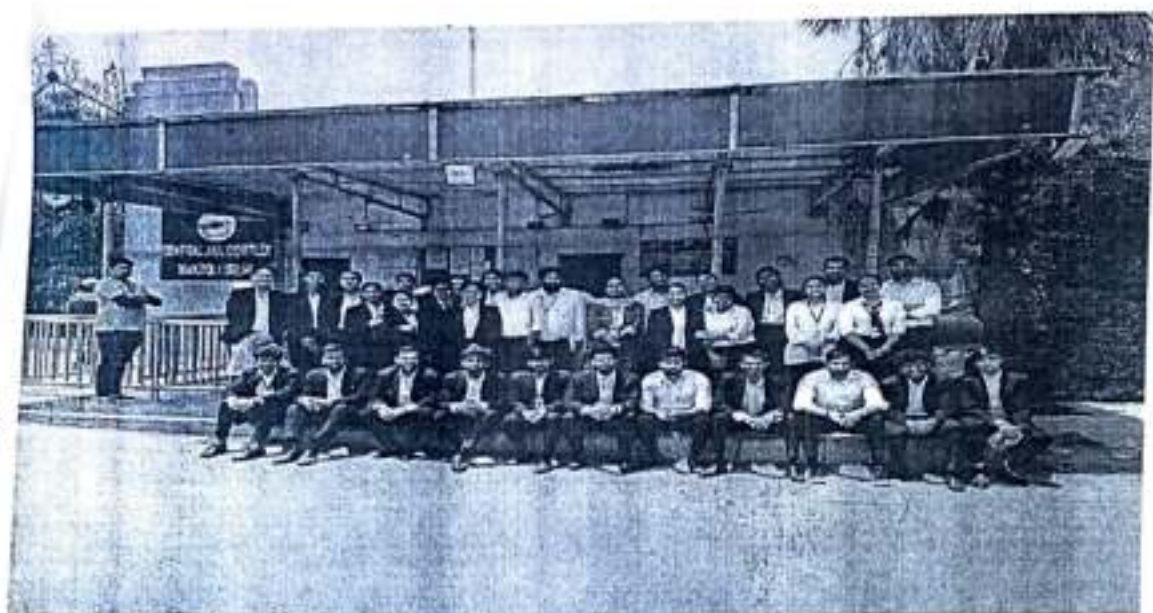

A Jail visit was organized for the School of Law students by the Legal Aid Clinic in association with DLSA (East). The students were accompanied by three faculty members of the School of Law, IIMT, namely, Dr. Jasdeep Singh (Associate Professor), Mr. Sidharth Rathore (Assistant Professor), and Ms. Anchal Gautam (Assistant Professor).			
Brief Description of Activity:			
The Jail Visit was designed to enhance the students understanding of the intricacies of the legal system through firsthand observayion and making them professional ready.			
<b>Different activities in Mandoli Jail:</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Meditation Hall:</b> For cleansing and disciplining mind, Yoga and meditation classes were started in a big way with the help of various voluntary organizations. We saw that the Staff members were also encouraged, to attend meditation courses.</li> <li><b>Educational Facilities and Vocational Training:</b> Both adult and formal education arrangements have been made for prisoners. Educational activities are looked after with the help of Government resources.</li> </ol>			
<b>Infrastructure Experience:</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Tailoring:</b> This unit is primarily started for imparting vocational training to convicts for post release rehabilitation. This section caters to tailoring requirements of prisoners and it also sells in different jail canteens. We saw some prisoners sewing some under-garments and handkerchiefs.</li> <li><b>Bakery:</b> Baking factory basically caters to bread requirements for morning tea. With the introduction of modern technology, this unit has now started manufacturing varieties of biscuits, cakes, namkeens etc. These products are not only available for sale through Dry canteens of various Jails but are also supplied to various Government departments.</li> <li><b>Kitchen:</b> There is huge hall for kitchen in which there are big electronic flour grinders and machine for making chapattis and also have gazettes for mixing up the flour. The inmates prepare their food for themselves. We also tasted the food that was made by inmates themselves. The food was hygienic and tasty. Also, prisoners are served food according to their strict diet chart, catering to their balanced diet needs.</li> </ol>			

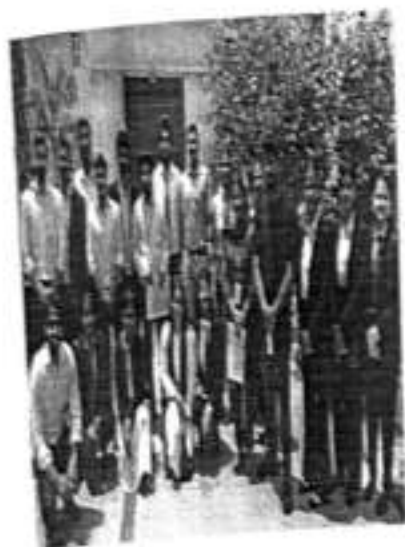
