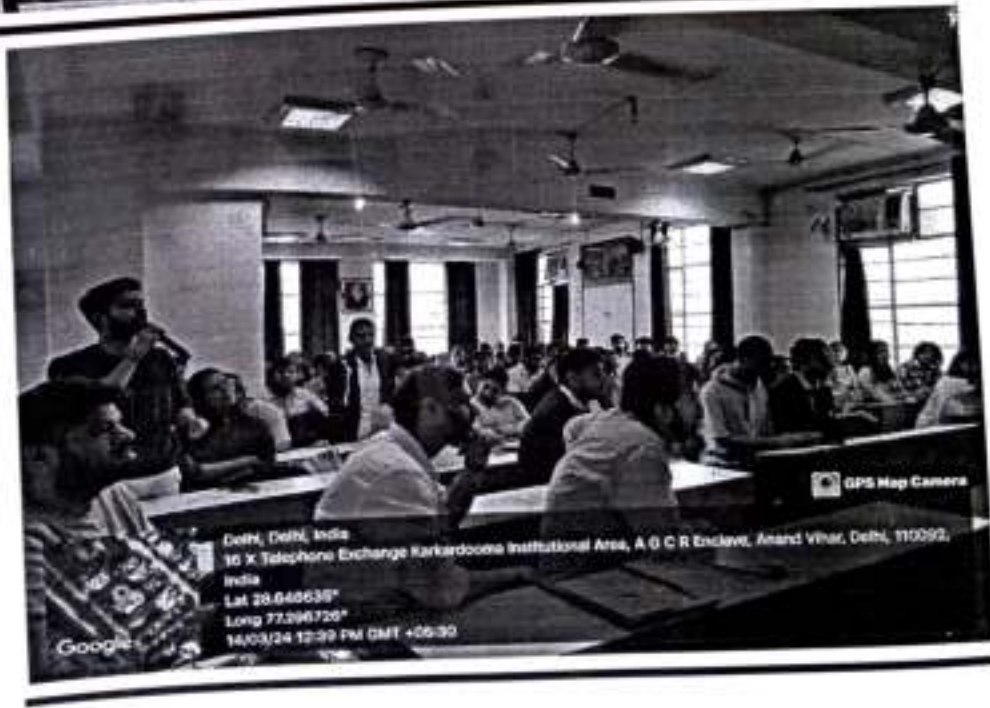

#### Brief Description of Activity:

On 4<sup>th</sup> April 2024, a case discussion regarding same-sex marriage was held at School of law, IIMT. The discussion aimed to foster a nuanced understanding of the legal, social, and ethical dimensions surrounding same-sex marriage, in light of the ongoing legal case of *Supriyo Chakroborthy v. UOI*. The case discussion involved students from LL.B 3<sup>rd</sup> Year and 4<sup>th</sup> Year. The diversity of perspectives enriched the discourse enabling a comprehensive exploration of the topic. This report reflects upon the key themes, arguments and insights generated during the discussion.

The participants debated the constitutional validity of denying same-sex couples the right to marry, citing Article 14 (Right to equality) and Article 21 (Right to life and personal liberty) of the Indian Constitution. Some argued that the judiciary should interpret constitutional provisions expansively to uphold the rights of marginalized groups, including the LGBTQ+ community, while others emphasized the need for legislative intervention for substantive legal change. The discussions delved into societal attitudes towards same-sex relationships and marriage, highlighting the influence of cultural, religious, and familial beliefs. Also, participants examined the role of education and awareness in challenging stigma and fostering acceptance of diverse sexual orientations and identities.

Human rights considerations, including the right to privacy and non-discrimination, were central to the discourse. Participants underscored the importance of ensuring equal rights and protections for all individuals, irrespective of sexual orientation. The discussion also addressed intersecting forms of discrimination faced by LGBTQ+ individuals, particularly concerning access to healthcare, employment, and housing.

The ethical dilemmas surrounding the recognition of same-sex marriage were explored, with participants grappling with questions of cultural relativism, individual autonomy, and the common good. Also, religious perspectives on homosexuality and marriage were raised, prompting reflections on the balance between religious


freedoms and secular principles in a pluralistic society.

The case discussion provided a platform for critical reflection and dialogue on the complex issues surrounding same-sex marriage. Participants demonstrated a keen awareness of the legal, social, and ethical dimensions of the topic, engaging in respectful exchanges of diverse viewpoints. The discussion on same-sex marriage underscored the importance of open dialogue and informed discourse in addressing contemporary social issues. By fostering empathy, understanding, and critical thinking, such discussions contribute to the cultivation of a more inclusive and equitable society. As the legal and social landscape regarding LGBTQ+ rights continues to evolve, initiatives like these play a vital role in shaping public discourse and advancing progress towards equality and justice for all.



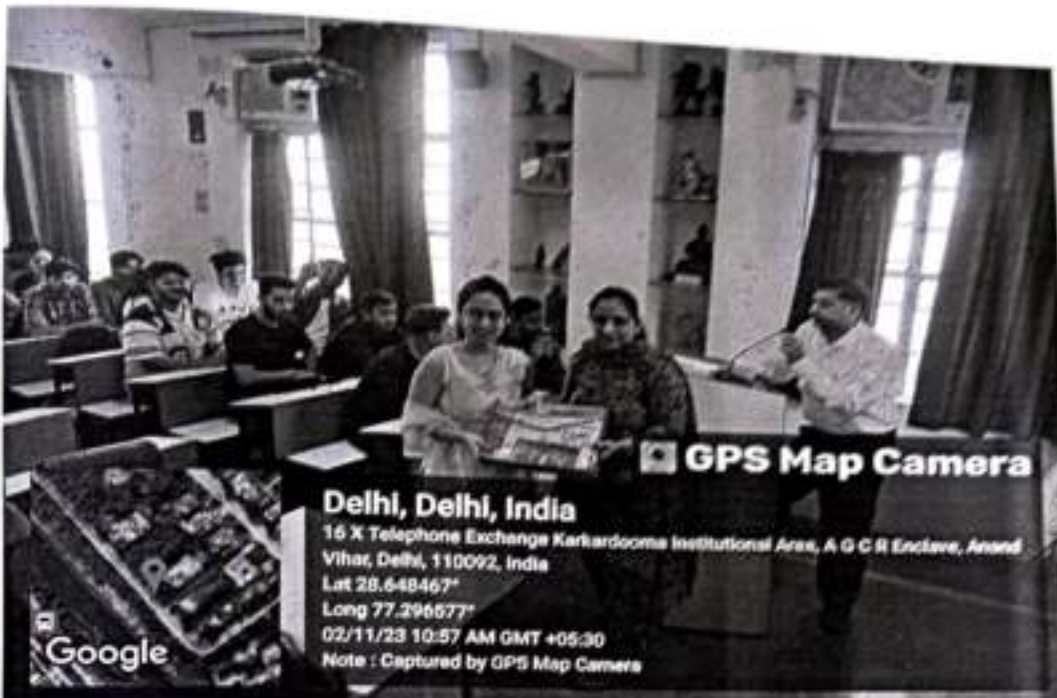
