ORPHANAGE AND OLD AGE HOME VISIT

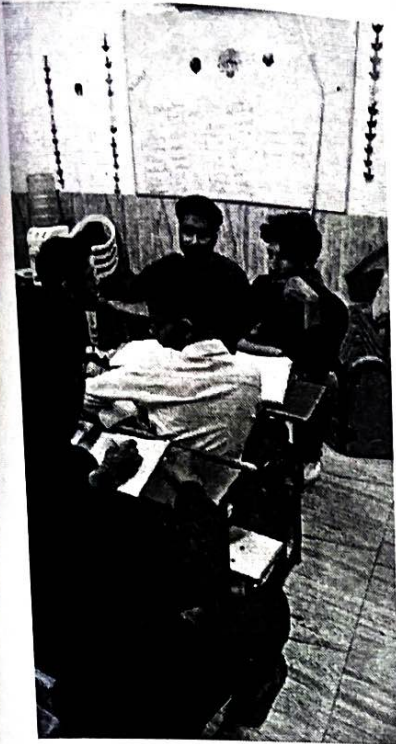
